THE EVERGREEN LEAVES OF LATE BLOOMING CORKSCREW ONION, LIKE TTS NAME SUGGESTS, SWIRL AROUND LIKE A BLUE GREEN COWLICK THEIR FUNTEXTURE ADDS SPARKLETOTHE FRONT OF ROCK GARDENS, HERB GARDENS, OR BORDERS. THE BUTTERFLY AND BEE ATTRACTING BLOOMS APPEAR IN LATE SUMMER AND ARE LIGHTLY FRAGRANT, PINKISH POMPOMS WITH BRIGHT YELLOW STAMENS. DROUGHTTOLERANT AND DEER RESISTANT, THIS LITTLE ALLIUM WILL REACH 10"-14" HIGH IN BLOOM AND FORMS DENSE, SLOWLY SPREADING, COWLICKY CLUMPS. FUN!
