

CONCORDE JAPANESE BARBERRY

BERBERIS THUNBERGII 'CONCORDE'



A SLIGHTLY SMALLER, MORE DENSELY FOLIAGED BARBERRY THAN THE FAMILIAR 'CRIMSON PYGMY', 'CONCORDE' HAS A DEEPER, MORE RELIABLE PLUM PURPLE COLOR IN ITS ROUNDED LEAVES. AS THORNY AND DEER RESISTANT AS ITS BETTER KNOWN COUSIN, IT REACHES 1 1/2'-2' TALL BY 3' WIDE, ALLOWING IT TO BE USED AS A TALL GROUND COVER OR EVEN EDGING. AS THE DAYS GROW SHORT IN AUTUMN, THE RICHLY COLORED FOLIAGE TRANSITIONS TO A BRIGHT CRIMSON, GIVING ONE LAST PUNCH OF COLOR BEFORE THE LEAVES DROP FOR WINTER. THE SMALL YELLOW BLOSSOMS, APPEARING IN SPRING, ARE ATTRACTIVE TO BEES AND ARE FOLLOWED BY FEW, IF ANY, VIABLE SEED, SIMULTANEOUSLY KEEPING THIS CULTIVAR IN CHECK IN AREAS WHERE JAPANESE BARBERRIES ARE KNOWN TO NATURALIZE AND ALLOWING THE PLANTS ENERGY TO BE FOCUSED ON LUXURIOUS GROWTH INSTEAD OF PRODUCING UNWANTED SEED. AN IMPROVED LANDSCAPING STAPLE.
