BERBERIS X GLADWYNENSIS 'WILLIAM PENN'



THIS IS ONE TOUGH EVERGREEN SHRUB, AND IT'S GOT THE THORNS TO PROVE IT! REACHING 4' HIGH X 5' ACROSS, IT MAKES AN IMPENETRABLE BARRIER WHEN PLANTED EN MASSE. THE SMALL YELLOW BLOSSOMS, APPEARING IN SPRING, CONTRAST BEAUTIFULLY WITH THE DARK, BLUE-GREEN LEAVES AND ARE GREAT POLLINATOR FODDER. THE TINY BLOSSOMS ARE SOON FOLLOWED BY LITTLE CYLINDRICAL POWDER BLUE BERRIES. TRULY A PLANT FOR ALL SEASONS, IT IS PERHAPS MOST INTERESTING IN WINTER, WHEN CHILLY TEMPERATURES BLUSH



THE FOLIAGE TO A DEEP WINE RED. DEER RESISTANT AND DROUGHT-TOLERANT, IT MAKES AN EASY ADDITION TO THE LANDSCAPE, WHERE ITS PRETTY ARCHING FORM AND RELATIVELY COMPACT SIZE MAKE IT A VALUABLE AS A STRUCTURAL ELEMENT. BARBERRIES MAKE GREAT HONEY PLANTS!
