BUTTONBUSH CEPHALANTHUS OCCIDENTALIS



A CALIFORNIA AND BEYOND NATIVE SHRUB COMMON ALONG WATERWAYS AND IN MOIST SOIL, BUTTONBUSH IS A HANDSOME SHRUB SPORTING PERKY WHITE, SPUTNIKSTYLE, FRAGRANT ORBS FOR BLOSSOMS. IN AREAS WHERE WATER LED EROSION IS A PROBLEM, IT IS A NATURAL PROBLEM SOLVER SPREADING TO 8 ACROSS BY 8-10 TALL IT PREFERS SOILTHAT STAYS MOIST TO WET, BUTTOLERATES DRYER POSITIONS ONCE ESTABLISHED. THE SCI-FI BLOOMS, APPEARING IN SPRING TO EARLY SUMMER, PROVIDE FOODER FOR HONEY BEES, AS WELL AS OTHER POLLINATORS, AND LENDTHEIR SWEET PERFUMETOTHE HONEY PRODUCED FROM THEIR NECTAR THE ROUND, RED FRUTT PERSIST ON THE PLANTINTO WINTER ADDING INTEREST TO OTHERWISE SUBDUED GARDENS.
