

EVERGREEN CLEMATIS

CLEMATIS ARMANDII

ONE OF THE TOUGHEST OF THE CLEMATIS FAMILY, SPRING BLOOMING EVERGREEN CLEMATIS GROWS QUICKLY TO FILL LARGE SPACES. THE SWEETLY FRAGRANT WHITE BLOSSOMS EMERGE IN HUGE QUANTITIES IN MARCH AND ARE QUITE ATTRACTIVE TO POLLINATORS OF ALL SORTS. LIKE ALL THE CLEMATIS, IT CLIMBS BY TWINING ITS LEAF STALKS AROUND A NARROW DIAMETER SUPPORT, AND SO IS GREAT FOR A CHAIN LINK FENCE, BUT WON'T MANAGE LATTICE WITHOUT THE HELP OF SOME WIRE OR THE LIKE. ALSO LIKE ALL CLEMATIS, IT PREFERS TO HAVE ITS FEET COOL AND ITS LEAVES IN THE SUN, SOMETHING EASILY ACCOMPLISHED BY MULCHING WELL. BUT UNLIKE MOST CLEMATIS, IT IS QUITE EASY TO CULTIVATE, DEMANDING LITTLE BUT GIVING A LOT. AND, OF COURSE, ALSO UNLIKE MOST OF ITS KIN, IT'S EVERGREEN, PROVIDING NON-STOP SCREENING IN ALL SEASONS!
