## FILIPENDULA HEXAPETALA



WITH ITS FERNLIKE APPEARANCE, THIS PERENNIAL WILL SURPRISE YOU WHEN ITS DELICATE, FOAMY WHITE FLOWERS EMERGE ON 2 FOOT TALL STALKS IN SPRING AND EARLY SUMMER. TOLERANT OF MANY CONDITIONS, INCLUDING WET, CLAY SOILS, MEADOWSWEET WILL EASILY FIND A HOME IN YOUR GARDEN. LONG USED AS A MEDICINAL HERB, IT IS ALSO REFERRED TO AS DROPWORT, GARDEN SPIREA, AND LADY'S RUFFLES. GREAT AS A SOFTENING ACCENT TO BULKIER PERENNIALS THAT ALSO ENJOY PARTIAL SHADE, SUCH AS FOXGLOVE, CORAL BELLS OR GEUM.
