MUCH LIKE THE MORE FAMILIAR VERSIONS OF CATMINT, THIS POLLINATOR HAVEN PUTS ON QUITE THE SUMMER SHOW OF LAVENDER BLOSSOMS. THIS PARTICULAR ONE IS A BIT DIFFERENT, THOUGH, IN THAT IT STAYS MORE COMPACT. REACHING ONLY ABOUT 18" TALL BY 2-2 1/2' ACROSS, IT MAKES A NICE FOREGROUND PLANT. STRONGLY MINTY-SCENTED, IT DEFIES DEER TO EAT IT, WHICH THEY HAVE NEVER YET FOR US. BEES ADORE THE ABUNDANT BLOOMS AND NO GARDEN HOPING TO FEED THE BEES SHOULD BE WITHOUT IT. DROUGHT-TOLERANT AND TOUGH, IT CAN BE CUT BACK AFTER BLOOM TO GROW OUT AND WILL OFTEN BLOOM AGAIN. A FRAGRANT ADDITION TO HERB GARDENS, ROCK GARDENS, OR JUST ABOUT ANYWHERE, IT ALSO MAKES A GOOD CONTAINER SUBJECT. VERY NICE!
