BOLD-TEXTURED PERENNIAL NATIVE TO THE MOUNTAINS OF SYRIA, HARDY JERUSALEM SAGE IS ADAPTED TO CLIMATES LIKE OURS IN THE SIERRA FOOTHILLS AREAS. HEAT, COLD, AND DROUGHT TOLERANT, IT IS AN EASY WAY TO ADD ARCHITECTURAL INTEREST TO YOUR PLANTINGS. ITS LARGE, FUZZY LEAVES ARE QUITE RESISTANT TO NIBBLING BROWSERS (A.K.A. DEER), WHILE ITS UNUSUAL SOFT YELLOW FLOWERS APPEARING SPRING INTO SUMMER ARE ATTRACTIVE TO HUMMINGBIRDS, BEES, AND BUTTERFLIES. ABOUT 3 FEET TALL (IN BLOOM) AND SPREADING, GROWING MORE SHOOTS FROM THE BASE OF THE PLANT EACH YEAR
