
POZO BLUE SAGE SALVIA CLEVELANDII X LEUCOPHYLLA POZO BLUE

THEIR STRONG PERFUME IS A BIT MUCH FOR SOME ATCLOSE PROXIMITY, BUT AT A DISTANCE, FILLS THE AIR WITH A LOVELY FLORAL SCENT, ESPECIALLY AFTER A RAIN. POZO BLUE IS A HYBRID OF 2 CALIFORNIA NATIVE SAGE SPECIES, BUT GROWS VERY LIKE A TRADITIONAL CLEVELAND SAGE. ITS MOUNDED, EVERGREEN FORM, WHICH REACHES AROUND 3-4TALL AND WIDE, IS TOPPED IN EARLY SUMMER BY LOVELY, BLUE, BUTTERFLY AND BEE ATTRACTING BLOOMSTHAT FORM SPHERICAL SHAPES SPACED ALONG THE-TALL BLOOM STALKS. A BIT MORE COLD HARDY AND EASIER TO CULTNATE-THAT-TRADITIONAL CALIFORNIA SAGES, IS MAINTAINS HIGH TOLERANCE TO BOTH DROUGHT AND DEER WONDERFUL!
