



# GREEN GIANT ARBORVITAE



## THUJA X STANDISHII 'GREEN GIANT'

FAST GROWING GREEN GIANT ARBORVITAE IS VALUABLE AS A SCREEN PLANTING THAT OUTDOES UNGAINLY LEYLAND CYPRESS ON ALL MEASURES. ELEGANT IN FORM, IT CAN ONLY BE CALLED GRACEFUL, SOMETHING IT HAS RECEIVED FROM ITS NATIVE WESTERN RED CEDAR PARENT. GROWING 2-4' PER YEAR, IT WILL QUICKLY FILL IN THE SPACE IT NEEDS TO, REACHING AN EVENTUAL 35-45' HIGH BY 10-12' WIDE IF ALLOWED. THE TREE IS EASILY PRUNED, OR EVEN SHEARED, TO MAINTAIN IT AT A LOWER HEIGHT, OR EVEN A HEDGE, BUT IS QUITE NICE AS A SPECIMEN AT ITS FULL SIZE. TOLERANT OF BOTH SANDY AND CLAY SOILS, IT IS WIDELY ADAPTABLE TO VARYING CONDITIONS, INCLUDING HEAT AND COLD, SUN AND SHADE, AND IS RESISTANT TO THE BROWSING OF DEER IN OUR AREA. MAY TURN BRONZY IN THE COLD OF WINTER, BUT GREENS UP LUSHLY AGAIN IN SPRING.
