IN A WORLD PRACTICALLY OVERFLOWING WITH NAMED VARIETIES OF NATIVE CALIFORNIA FUCHSIA, THIS ONE IS A STAND OUT! RATHER THAN THE BRIGHT ORANGE-RED OF MOST, SOLIDARTY PINK FEATURES TOO PRETTY TO PASS UP, SOFT PINK BLOSSOMS. REACHING A SOMEWHAT DIMINUTIVE 1' HIGH BY 2' WIDE, IT HAS NICE, PASTEL GREEN FOLIAGE, TOO. EQUALLY AS ATTRACTIVE TO HUMMINGBIRDS AS MORE KNOWN VARIETIES, IT GIVES GARDENERS THAT LEAN TOWARD A SOFTER COLOR SCHEME AN OPTION. BLOOMING IN LATE SUMMER TO FALL, THE CALIFORNIA FUCHSIAS ARE ABSOLUTELY GEARED TO FEED HUMMINGBIRDS ON THEIR ANNUAL MIGRATION, AND BELIEVE ME, THE BIRDS KNOW IT. CUT BACK IN WINTER AND DON'T DISMAY IN SPRING AS IT IS SLOW TO WAKE FROM ITS WINTER SLUMBER, BUT COMES BACK BIGGER AND BETTER EACH YEAR.
