SEDUM HUMISIFUSUM TINY URCHIN

ONE OF THE CUTEST OF THE VERY LARGE SEDUM TRIBE, THIS TINY SUCCULENT LOOKS FOR ALL THE WORLD, TO US, AT LEAST, LIKE MOSS. IF YOU LOVE THAT MOSSY LOOK, BUT HAVEN'T THE CLIMATE FOR IT, THIS PETITE TEXTURED SUCCULENT MAY BE YOUR ANSWER. SEAFOAM GREEN AND TIGHTLY PACKED WITH MINUTE LEAVES, THE OVERALL EFFECT IS SOFT AND PILLOWY. TEMPTED AS YOU MAY BE, THOUGH, WE DON'T RECOMMEND WALKING ON IT. INSTEAD, LET IT FILL SPACES BETWEEN STONES IN ROCK GARDENS AND STONE WALLS, OR EVEN STAND ALONE IN A TINY CONTAINER (FAIRY GARDEN, ANYONE?.) LIKE ALL OF THE STONECROPS, IT IS DROUGHT-TOLERANT AND WANTS TO DRY OUT BETWEEN WATERING. FROST WON'T HURT IT, BUT SOGGY SOIL CAN, SO PROVIDE AS GOOD OF DRAINAGE AS POSSIBLE.
